GAME NOTES

IOWA

- Is the first team this season to beat Illinois twice. The Illini beat Northwestern (2/22/26), Wisconsin (3/4/26), and Michigan State (3/5/26) in their second matchups.
- Held Illinois to just 33.3% from the floor, their lowest percentage this season.
- Held Illinois' second-leading Cearah Parchment to just two points, which is her lowest in a game this season.
- Had four players score in double-figures led by Ava Heiden with 16. The last time Iowa had four players score in double figures was in a win over Purdue on Feb. 19 this season.

ILLINOIS

- Jasmine Brown-Hagger scored a season-high 22 points for the Illini on 8-13 shooting.
- With the win over Michigan State yesterday, Shauna Green is second all-time in wins at Illinois (84).
- Played 10 ranked teams this season and beat three, which ties the most ranked wins in a season under Green.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Iowa returns to the semifinals for the first time since the Hawkeyes won the Big Ten Tournament in 2024.
- Iowa is set to play the winner of No. 3 seed Michigan vs. No. 11 seed Oregon. The Hawkeyes beat both in the regular season.
