GAME NOTES

Illinois

- Had four players score in double figures, led by Berry Wallace with 22 points and Destiny Jackson with 21 points.
- Shot 82.8% from the free throw line, the highest percentage in a Big Ten Tournament game since shooting 87.5% against Rutgers in 2023.
- The Illini scored 24 points off 19 Badger turnovers and 14 fast break points.
- Converted on 65% of two-point field goals and outscored Wisconsin 46 to 28 in the paint.
- Cearah Parchment scored 14 points for Illinois, the most for an Illini freshman in a Big Ten Tournament game since Adalia McKenzie scored 18 points in the second round against Nebraska in 2022.

Wisconsin

- Senior forward Gift Uchenna scored 24 points, which was her third 20+ point performance this season.
- The Badgers held Illinois to just 10.5% on three-point attempts and made six more than the Illini from behind the arc.
- Assisted on 21 out of 26 field goals and was led by senior Ronnie Porter, who tallied five assists on her own.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Marks the Illini's first Big Ten Tournament win since 2023 when the Illini bested No. 11 Rutgers 81-55.
- Will face Michigan State in the second round, who leads the all-time series versus Illinois 49-29 and has not lost to the Illini since January 29, 2023.
